Tribute To Ronald Clery

IT is indeed with a great deal of sadness and shock that the Board of Management and members of the Saint Lucia Gee-Ryu Karate-Do Association (SGKA) mourn the passing of one of its members, *Sensei Ronald Clery*, son of Grandmaster Paul Clery (Founder of the Association), and Mrs. Genitha Clery, of Pavee, Castries.

Ronald died at the Victoria Hospital on the evening of Monday, November 26, 2012, the exact day of his 20th birthday. He was admitted to hospital the previous Saturday (November 24, 2012).

Ronnie, as he was affectionately called, was a member of the Association from its establishment four years ago, on December 19, 2008. During those years, Ronnie took his training seriously by attending every session to the point where he became a Junior Instructor, and elevated to the rank of a Black Belt. He was an outstanding karateka destined to take his place in annals of the sport of Karate on Saint Lucia, but the good Lord had other plans for him.

To all those who knew Ronnie, he was a very quiet, unassuming and respectful young man. He recently left the Corinth Secondary School and took up employment, until he began to complain of pain to the back of his head a few days prior to being rushed to hospital.

Ronnie's gentleness, calmness and general deportment was the envy of many of the friends with whom he associated.

There is no doubt that Ronnie will be greatly missed by all. Farewell, my friend, farewell!!!
